1. POTHICHORU AND STUDENT AID PROGRAMME

The identification and moulding of gifted youths and help them to develop their potential to the fullest by enhancement of the powers of the mind is a major concern of higher education. Under the guidance of the teachers, the college union offers helping hands to those who need assistance in society by the POTHICHORU initiative and STUDENT AID programme in the nearby Midayikunnu L P school.

OBJECTIVES

- Inculcation of values among students
- Enable students to understand the act of helping a needy person as their responsibility rather than as a charitable activity
- To think beyond the classrooms
- To Infuse in the minds of students the love and care for the society

THE PRACTICE

The college union takes initiative in providing “Pothichoru”, noon meals every Friday to the inmates of Sevagram and Avedha Bhavan (in Sevagram the inmates are terminally ill patients and Avedha Bhavan houses mentally challenged ladies). It has been practicing from several years back. More than 150 meals has been distributed every week. For that each student as well as teachers bring an extra packet of their lunch they prepared from home. The union representatives will collect food packets from the students and the collected food packets are distributed in the near by charitable centres namely Sevagram and Avedha Bhavanam.

During the time of flood, the college has been a camp for the hundreds of people in the flood affected areas near by the college. The college union students has effectively taken initiatives to provide food and clothes to the affected people.

The college union has been providing learning aid assistance to the students of Government L.P. school Midayikunnu. Not only the students but also the teaching staffs and non-teaching staffs also take part in this helping hand which has been going on for years.
