
STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY

2020-2021

Student Satisfaction Survey of the institution for the academic year 2020-2021 was carried out to assess the overall performance of the institution in academic and non academic activities. The survey was conducted by circulating Google forms among students. SSS includes questions recommended by NAAC and other relevant aspects of the Institution. Among the students who participated in the survey, 73.6% were females and 26.4% were males and 74.6% were pursuing Bachelor's degrees and the rest were doing their Master's.


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

Major fraction of students (87.5%) are of the opinion that more than 80% of the syllabus is covered during the course. Only a very minor fraction (<10%) have a difference in opinion




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

The survey clearly indicates that students consider that the teachers prepare well for the classes. A fraction of 32.4% suggests that teachers prepare thoroughly for classes, 63% opinionated that the preparation is satisfactory and the rest feel it poor or unsatisfactory




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

Regarding the communication of the teachers with the students, most of them find it very effective. A small fraction of around 17% find it ineffective




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

The teaching approach is considered excellent by around 33% of students and very good by 42.7%, which is a huge fraction. Around 19.3% find it good and the rest fair




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

Internal evaluation is an important parameter for assessment of students and the fairness of internal evaluation by teachers is regarded as always fair or usually fair by around 86.5% of students




6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

A major fraction of children opinionated that the assignments given are discussed with them. A small fraction are in a view that the discussion is done rarely or occasionally




7. The institute takes an active interest in promoting internships, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth

Mentoring is carried out in a systematic way in the institution and the students find that the mentoring process helps in their overall development, as indicated by the survey




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes, and program outcomes

Discussions on course outcomes, programs outcomes are effectively done by the faculties




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you

Mentor follows up the task assigned to the students, indicating a healthy mentor-student relationship




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications

The teaching method involves illustration of concepts through examples and applications, as indicated by feedback report




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing the right level of challenges

Considerable fraction of students believe that teachers identifies their strength and encourages them to face challenges




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them

Only around 66% of students are in the opinion that they help to identify and overcome their weakness




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process




16. The institute/ teachers use student-centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences

The teachers adopt student-centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences among students. This is supported by the feedback report




17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

Teachers also promote extracurricular activities in students as a fraction of about 72% of students agreed to it




18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills, and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work


19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching

Another shortcoming of the institution is the lack of ICT enabled classrooms and teaching methods adopting such methods. This is clearly indicated in the survey report




20. How effective was the overall online teaching during pandemic?


21. How satisfied are you with the online teaching and learning process?

Students are generally not much satisfied with the online teaching and learning process as only 17% found it extremely satisfactory




22. How satisfied are you in regard with the e- content (videos, ppts, voice notes etc) shared during online teaching?

Regarding the e-content shared during online teaching, students are almost satisfied




23. The overall quality of the institution's library facility
